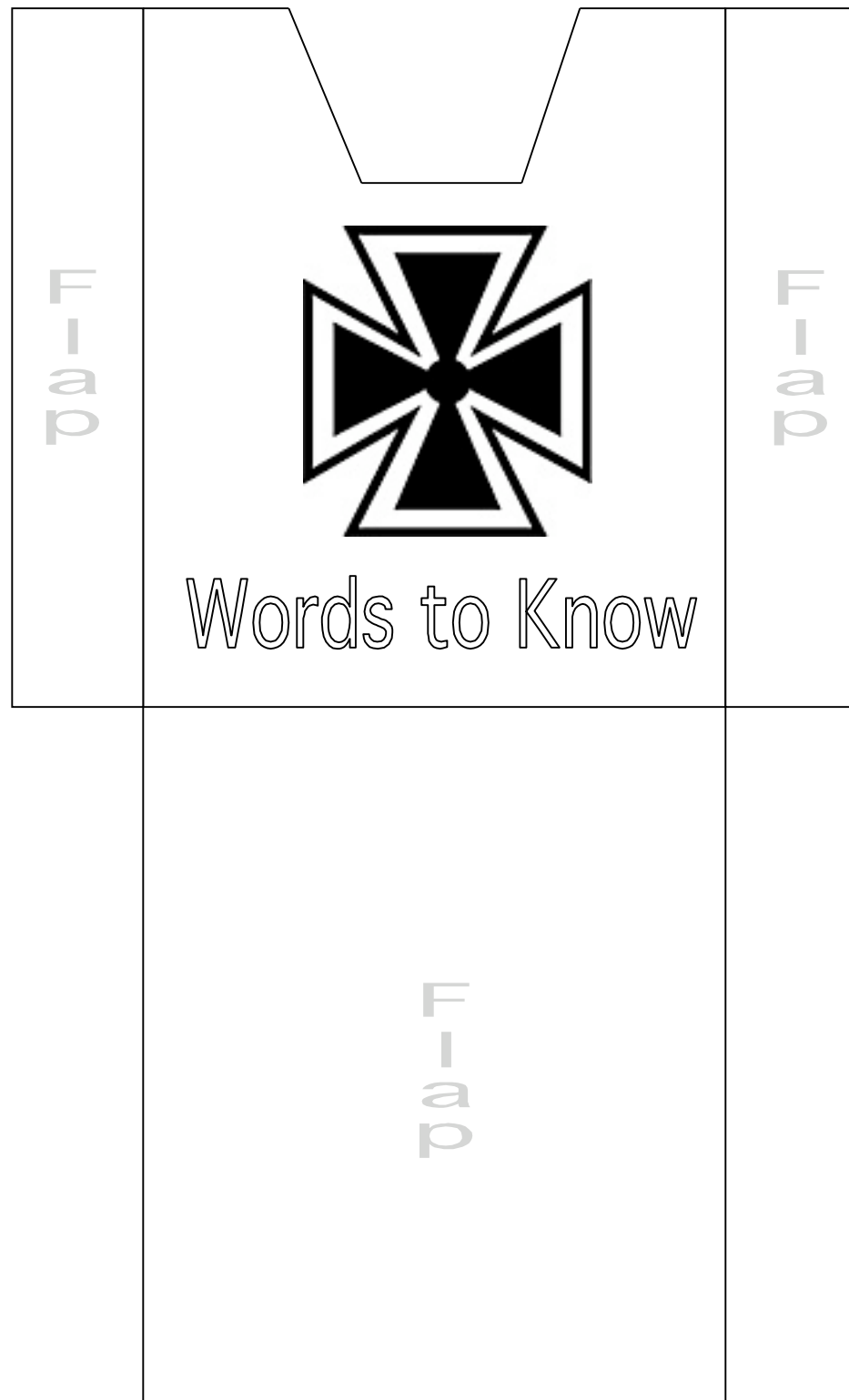


- Copy pocket and vocabulary cards on card stock.
